

#### Contact the Advisors

- A "C-" minimum is required in all course requirements unless specified otherwise.
- Refer to Degree Works to find the required courses for your program.
- Prerequisite courses must be completed first. As ENGL 1100 and CMNS 1290 are pre-admission requirements for the program, these courses should be completed in the first possible semester.
- Confirm the course availability by using online course schedule
- Know the important <u>dates and deadlines</u>
- Students are encouraged to make alternative plans in case their transfer credit is denied, or the course availability changes, and/or other circumstances arise.
