- Completed applications, including student information and references, must be received by *TRU Student Awards & Financial Aid* by **March 1** for scholarship applications, and by **April 1** for award applications.
- Those receiving an offer will be notified by **April 15** for scholarship offers and by **May 15** for award offers.
