## TRU BUDGET COMMITTEE OF SENATE (BCOS) REPORT BASED ON THE SEPTEMBER 12, 2017 MEETING OF BCOS

- 1. The Chair of BCOS outlined changes to process with regards to BCOS and APPC consideration of new programme proposals. Past practice was for APPC to consider programme proposals and then refer them to BCOS for consultation. In the future, all new programme proposals will be sent to BCOS and APPC at the same time.

- 6. The Applied Sustainable Ranching Certificate & Diploma changes have been reviewed by BCOS
- 7. Y. Laflamme, Director of Financial Planning and Budget, presented Powerpoint on budget processes and timelines for the 18/19 Budget Cycle. She offered to provide BCOS members a "Budget 101" workshop on the budget methodology used.
- 8. M. Milovick, VP Administration and Finance, asked BCOS members to review last year's budget assumptions and provide feedback.
