 - On motion duly made and adopted it was RESOLVED that BCOS recommend to the President and the Board of Governors that domestic tuition fees be set at \$24,480 for 2020 entry, and international tuition fees be set at \$35,700 for 2020 entry, for the Masters of Science in Data Science.
